

# POWER AND POWERLESSNESS ESSAY

*Powerlessness serves to re-enforce powerlessness"(Gaventa,). An Analysis of Power and Powerlessness, a Novel by John Gaventa. An Examination of the Oppressive and Desperate Situation of the Appalachian Coal Miners in the Power and Powerlessness by John Gaventa.*

This is especially true when dealing with shadow work and thus social scientists have developed concepts, theories and values to aid analysis and interpretation of facts. As well as that, the critical approach intends to judiciously evaluate the function of these institutions and social structures in regards to the power relationship within them with an end goal of alleviating the struggle of those marginalized, exploited, and oppressed. Conversely, if one were to advance the cause of the reform movement and upset the system, life could be made very difficult for them. Now, during this time of divorce a great focus seems to be drawn between the adults, but at what point should we wonder about the children. The concepts of power and powerlessness are evidently portrayed through the uses of several techniques such as metaphors, allegory, contrast and oxymoron. In this way, ties to the past were severed and a clear path for a new society was created. These situations span a wide spectrum of severity, but they are common occurrences for all. Although 'B' was originally aware of their state of oppression, time has quelled the initial fear and has desensitized their drive to remain unconstrained and autonomous. If he were to refuse, there could be trouble. Each of the contributors was to have received a copy of Havel's essay and then to respond to it. An individual living within such a system must live a lie, to hide that which he truly believes and desires, and to do that which he must do to be left in peace and to survive. The term empowerment in itself denotes that there is powerlessness. They need not accept the lie. As society is not egalitarian and never shall be, there will always be inequalities.
